

Heart to Heart International providing free medical care after Hurricane Michael

October 17, 2018 – Heart to Heart International (HHI) has medical teams in multiple locations in Panama City, Florida, providing free medical care.

The main location is at the Deane Bozeman high school shelter, where a mobile medical clinic has been positioned. Doctors and nurses are there to provide treatment for a variety of issues, plus medication refills and tetanus vaccines.

Medical teams have seen more than 200 patients since the hurricane and will be continuing to serve those in need.

Heart to Heart International is a nonprofit international health organization with its headquarters in Lenexa, Kansas. Since its inception in 1992, HHI has delivered medical aid and supplies worth \$1.6 billion to more than 130 countries, including within the United States. HHI responds to crises and natural disasters both domestically and internationally by supplying medical relief and mobilizing volunteers.
